Geocaching is a real-world, outdoor treasure hunting game using GPS-enabled devices. Participants navigate to a specific set of GPS coordinates and then attempt to find the geocache (container) hidden at that location.

HOW TO GEOCACHE USING YOUR PHONE:

Using the official Geocaching app

1. Download geocaching.com app.
2. Create an account.
3. The app will open to your current location.
4. Click on one of the green geocaches.
5. Touch the information box. When ready to go, touch "Navigate."
6. Navigate on established trails.
7. Once within 9 feet of the geocache location, use the descriptions and clues to start looking for the cache.
8. When you find the cache (or if you don't), log it on your app!
9. If there is a log paper inside, be sure to sign your name so other people know you found it, too!

Alternate App: GeocachingOne

WHAT ARE YOU LOOKING FOR?

A small container anywhere from the size of a film canister to a small shoebox. They are hidden out of view so a casual passerby will not see or notice them. Please do not take a trade item unless you have something to leave. Return the container to its hiding spot.

Using Sarett Nature Center's GPS units

1. Turn unit on by holding POWER button on right side of device.
2. Press PAGE button until MENU appears. Press DOWN button until WAYPOINTS is in black box. Press ENTER 2 times.
3. Sarett's GPS units are pre-programmed. See waypoint number by our caches listed.
4. Use the UP and DOWN button until desired waypoint is in the black box.
5. With "Go To" selected Press ENTER.
6. Follow the arrow on the "compass" as a guide to direct you on the trail. When time is 10 seconds or less, begin looking for the cache.
7. Sign the logbook if you find the cache!
